Lake Canadohta Historical Society Celebrates Three Years of Great Memories

Just a quick review of all the really great things the LCHS has accomplished since 2020 when they were incorporated.

During the pandemic in 2020 we spent our time getting incorporated and getting the 501C3 certification.

In 2021 we had our first Speaker Series on the Saturday of Labor Day weekend. George Eisentrout was the first distinguished speaker with an excellent program on the history of the Old Hotel on the Southwest side of the Lake. It was very well attended, we used every chair available at the Activity Building of Our Lady of Fatima. It was a great talk and can be viewed on our Facebook group, Lake Canadohta Historical Society,

In 2022 we had three Programs during the summer. Our first program was on the history of Lincolnville and was presented by Dale Burgess and Gayle Geer Amann. The second program of the summer was presented by Andy and Rick Mason. They did an amazing history of the family business, The Canadohta Skating Rink. On the Saturday of Labor Day weekend we hosted a really fun session of "Show us your Treasures". Several "Lakers" showed us some great artifacts and identified some information.

In the fall of 2022 we interviewed Nancy and Harold Higby. They gave us a very interesting history of their life and their cottages, store and campgrounds. We videoed the whole interview and it can be seen on the Lake Canadohta Historical Society Facebook page.



Baxter grew up at Canadohta Lake and has a wealth of history of this area. His father owned several businesses at Canadohta Lake, including the Original Putter Golf, the Horse Stables and the Lake View Inn before it became Pier 66. Baxter's talk will be held on Saturday June 10 at 10:30 am at the Activity Building of Our Lady of Fatima on Lake Road.




commemorative t-shirts later in the season.

TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE SUN! IT'S NOW OR "NEVER"?

Next April Canadohta Lake will be treated to an unforgettable sight-a Total Eclipse of the Sun-so you might want to make some lake plans for the spring! A total solar eclipse only happens when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth obscuring the view of the Sun.

Total eclipses of the Sun occur at any place on Earth about every 375 years, but that's just an average. Some places have not had one for over a thousand years! Some places, like Carbondale, Illinois saw the last Total Eclipse on August 21, 2017 and will also



April 8, 2024 will be your big chance to experience the Moon's shadow. But, you might ask, what's so special about that. If you were at the lake in 2017, you saw only a partial eclipse because you were outside the path, but that's a far cry from what is coming up next year. Eclipse chasers like to say that on a scale of 1-10, a partial eclipse is about a three and a total eclipse is a million! This time the lake will be inside the path of totality (and hopefully you will be, too).

Your next question might be, "How long will it last?" It can be anywhere from one second to a little over seven minutes. The latest one that grazed the western coast of Australia on April 20, 2023, was only 60 seconds, but next April you will be luckier with about four minutes of totality to enjoy, depending on exactly where you are in the path.

Truly, there is nothing like being in the Moon's shadow as it sweeps across Earth. The sky gets dark, the temperature drops, you might feel a chill—even in summer. It's a mesmerizing event. People shout, jump up and down, utter words not repeatable in front of small children, or even cry. Some have described totality as a hole in the sky. Some say it twinkles. You will have to come up with your own description, but you will find it impossible to truly describe to someone who wasn't there. When it's over everyone wants to know, when's the next one!

On that topic, the next total eclipse that goes through the United States won't be until August 12, 2045! And it won't be visible from Canadohta Lake! So this one is a must see event. And don't think about waiting for the next next eclipse at the lake, because that won't happen until September 12, 2444 and


But back to April 8, 2024. Every total eclipse begins and ends with a partial eclipse and you will need solar filters to safely view these stages. It is only when the sky gets dark and the Sun disappears completely behind the Moon that is it safe to look with unprotected eyes. In fact, if you don't take your solar filters off then, you won't see anything!

But what still could prevent you from seeing this fascinating event is the weather. Check the weather forecast about five days before and see if it stays the same or keeps changing. If clouds threaten, look for clear spots within driving distance. Try to have a Plan B. That's real eclipse chasing!



Kayak Dice Run

CLABA is having two kayak dice runs this year. One on June 24, 2023 and one on July 29, 2023. Keep reading on for all the info of what to do to join in on the fun! The fee to participate is \$10. The first 100 entrants get a fun gift that is always a surprise and everyone gets a Canadohta Lake Coozie. You start out by registering at The Pond Bar and Grille Pavilion, this can be done on the Friday night before the Kayak Dice Run from 7pm-8pm or the or the day of the Dice Run starting at 9:30. The next step is to put your kayak in the water, and you can do that from anywhere around the lake. There is a boat launch on the west side of the lake that you can use to put your kayak in the water. If you use the boat launch, you will need to have a current launch permit or registration on your kayak. For more information about this see the PA Fish and Boat Commission website at fishandboat.com.

The Kayak Dice Run goes from 10am – 2pm on the day of the run. This is not a race. You can start paddling any time you want, you just need to turn your tally sheet in by 2pm to be counted for the prizes. There are 4 manned stations around the lake (See map to the left). When you pull your kayak up to the station you will give the attendant your tally sheet and they will hand you a container of dice to shake. The dice stay in the container and you stay in your kayak the entire time! What could be easier? The attendant will write your dice total on your tally sheet, give it back to you and you will paddle on to the next station. Stations can be done in any order that you want. The last station is at the The Pond Bar and Grille Pavilion. You do not need to paddle into this station, you can pack up your kayak and drive or walk to the pavilion for your last dice roll. If you do paddle to this station, please do not paddle into the beach area of the Frog Pond!

The last dice roll is at the The Pond Bar and Grille Pavilion. Your dice will be totaled, and you will see how you did compared to others. As soon as the warmer weather hits everyone cannot wait to get out on the Lake! If your family is like ours we practically live on the water during the summer months. At any given time, a group of boats all tied up enjoying the sun, the water, family, and friends. Everyone's time on Canadohta should be relaxing and stress free. No matter if you own a boat or you are renting, there are a few safety requirements you need to know. All boat operators are responsible for knowing the rules and regulations in the areas where they boat. Knowing the waters where they are boating, and having the required safety equipment for their watercraft. Operators are also responsible for the actions of all persons on board their boat. Onboard every passenger needs to have a USCG-approved wearable life jacket. In addition to wearable life jackets, boats 16 feet and over must have a USCG-approved throwable device (ring buoy, life ring, or buoyant seat cushion) on board. Canoes, kayaks, and paddleboards, regardless of length, are not required to carry a throwable device. Children 12 years old and younger on Commonwealth waters when underway on any boat 20 feet or less in length are required to be wearing a life jacket. This also applies to all canoes, kayaks, and paddleboards. Boaters are also required, by law, to wear life jackets on boats less than 16 feet in length or any canoe, kayak, or paddleboard during the cold water months from November 1 through April

Motorboats less than 65 feet in length must carry some mechanical means of making a sound signal. This device may be hand, mouth, or power operated. An athletic coach's whistle is an acceptable device for small motorboats. Operators of unpowered boats (canoes, kayaks, rowboats, paddleboards) are required to carry a device capable of sounding a prolonged blast for 4-6 seconds that can be heard by another boat operator in time to avoid a collision. An athletic coach's whistle is acceptable. All powered motorboats are also required to carry a USCG approved fire extinguisher. Fire extinguishers must be immediately available and installed (mounted away from the fuel source). They must be fully charged, in usable (good) condition, and inspected regularly. Make sure everyone on your boat knows the location of the fire extinguisher and its use.

Operators are also responsible for operating at a rate of speed that does not endanger the life or property of any person, or is greater than slow, no-wake speed within 100 feet of the shoreline, docks, launch ramps, swimmers, or downed skiers, persons wading in the water, anchored, moored, or drifting boats, and floats. All boats must also show required running lights between the hours of sunset and sunrise and during periods of restricted visibility, such as fog and heavy rain. During these times, no other lights may be displayed, except those that cannot be mistaken for the required lights or do not impair their visibility, or interfere with keeping a proper lookout. Following these rules and all the other rules located in the Boater Safety Handbook can help ensure a safe summer boating season for everyone at Canadohta Lake. Here's to hoping everyone has a hot and safe 2023 boating season!
